SK Post Operative Instructions

- Rest today.
- Advance diet as tolerated.
- Leave the eye patch in place. Remove tomorrow morning.
- Do not rub the operative eye.
- Avoid dusty, dirty situations, keep sweat out of the eye. Keep hands clean.
- Report any severe pain, increased redness or discharge, or decreased vision in the operative eye to your physician immediately.
- Take Tylenol or Ibuprofen or over the counter medications as directed for any discomfort.
- You may wash your hair the day after surgery, but avoid excessive water in the operative eye.
- Check with your surgeon regarding the use of cosmetics after surgery.
- Post op appointment at Eye Associates

Start the following drops after patch is removed.

Ofloxacin: Instill one drop into the operative eye 6 times daily.

Prednisolone: Instill one drop into operative eye twice a day.
