Eye Drops:

- 1. Further instructions will be given to you during your post-op appointment today after your surgery. Upon returning home after surgery, start eye drops as directed.
- 2. Artificial tears as needed for dry itchy eyes.
- 3. When taking drops, space them five minutes apart.

You will experience:

- Your vision will be blurry, hazy and cloudy.
- Your vision may get a little worse as the day goes on.
- Your eye will tear frequently.
- Your eye will feel scratchy and sore.
- There will be mild swelling and inflammation.
- Each eye is unique and it's common for each eye to feel differently after surgery.
- These symptoms will improve by next week.

DO:

• Wear your shield at bedtime for 3 nights.

You May:

- Allow clean water on your face while bathing or showering.
- · Resume normal daily activities tomorrow.

DON'T:

- Rub your eye.
- Poke yourself in the eye.
- Swim or hot-tub for two weeks
- Wear any eye make-up for 1 week

Contact 911 or Palmer Eye Center promptly with the following symptoms

- Significant and progressive reduction in vision.
- Increasing and severe pain.
- Progressive swelling and redness in the skin around the eye.
